# Changes

- Supreme is replacing the “Surge with Service” program model with a new “Faith In Action” program model
- This will take effect for the 2018-2019 Fraternal Year. The new model is expected to be fully implemented by July 1
- The new programs will be Faith, Family, Community and Life
- Councils will no longer need to appoint a Youth or Council Director
- The good news is this will reduce the number of programs required to earn the Columbian award. There will be 4 programs in 4 categories, totaling 16 programs, instead of the old 24 programs across 6 categories
