51st EXEMPLIFICATION OF THE FOURTH DEGREE – April 6, 2019

Honoree:

Location: St. Mary of the Mills Catholic Church, Keesler Parish Center, 800 Main St., Laurel, MD 20707 (as one approaches from the South, 8th Street becomes St. Mary's Place as it crosses Montgomery Street. Continuing on St. Mary's Place, one will pass Pallotti High School on the left and St. Mary's Church on the right, and then the Keesler Center and parking lot are on the left just before the downhill to the intersection with Main Street. Coming off MD 216 from the East, turn right on Main Street and the Keesler Center will be ahead on the left. The large "Msgr. Keesler Parish Center" sign will be visible on the corner of Main and St. Mary's.

Eligibility: Each candidate must be: (1) A third degree member in good standing in his council, and (2) a citizen of the country in which he resides. A citizen of another nation may participate with the specific written approval of both the Master of the appropriate District where he claims citizenship and the Master of the Archdiocese of Washington District.

Fees: Full payment, made payable to **Master, Fourth Degree Knights of Columbus**, is due with the submission of each application and registration form. The exemplification fee for candidates is \$70.00. Please note that this fee does not constitute payment of dues to the Assembly. A special exemplification fee for priests is \$35.00. Each exemplification fee includes one (1) luncheon ticket. Additional luncheon tickets are available at a cost of \$30.00 per person, and Ladies Activity tickets are available at a cost of \$20 per person.

All applications, luncheon reservations, and fees, must be received by March 23, 2019. There are no refunds or changes after this date. **NOTE:** Remember that every candidate's application must be received, voted on, and approved by the Assembly before submission. Dress: Candidates' dress shall be black or dark (blue or grey) business suit with black shoes, white dress shirt and tie, and candidate identification (identification provided by the secretary to the master). Armed forces, police, and firefighters may wear Class A or dress uniform. Sir Knight spectators will wear the same dress as candidates and add the Fourth degree emblem pin (PG-113). Religious may wear their clerical attire. The Color Guard, Honor Guard and Line Guards will be in the new uniform or full regalia, with the PG-113 pin as in the past. ***No other attire or formalwear is acceptable.***
