Youth Protection FAQ



- Does my clearance from other organizations count (NO)
- How long do we have to complete the requirements (30 Days)
- Impact of not completing the requirements
 - Loss of Star Council
 - No awards from State or Supreme
 - Removal from position
 - Forbidden from conducting Programs
- Risks
 - Expose the council and council leader to ligation
 - **Missing the signs of abuse and thus allowing a child to continue to be hurt**
