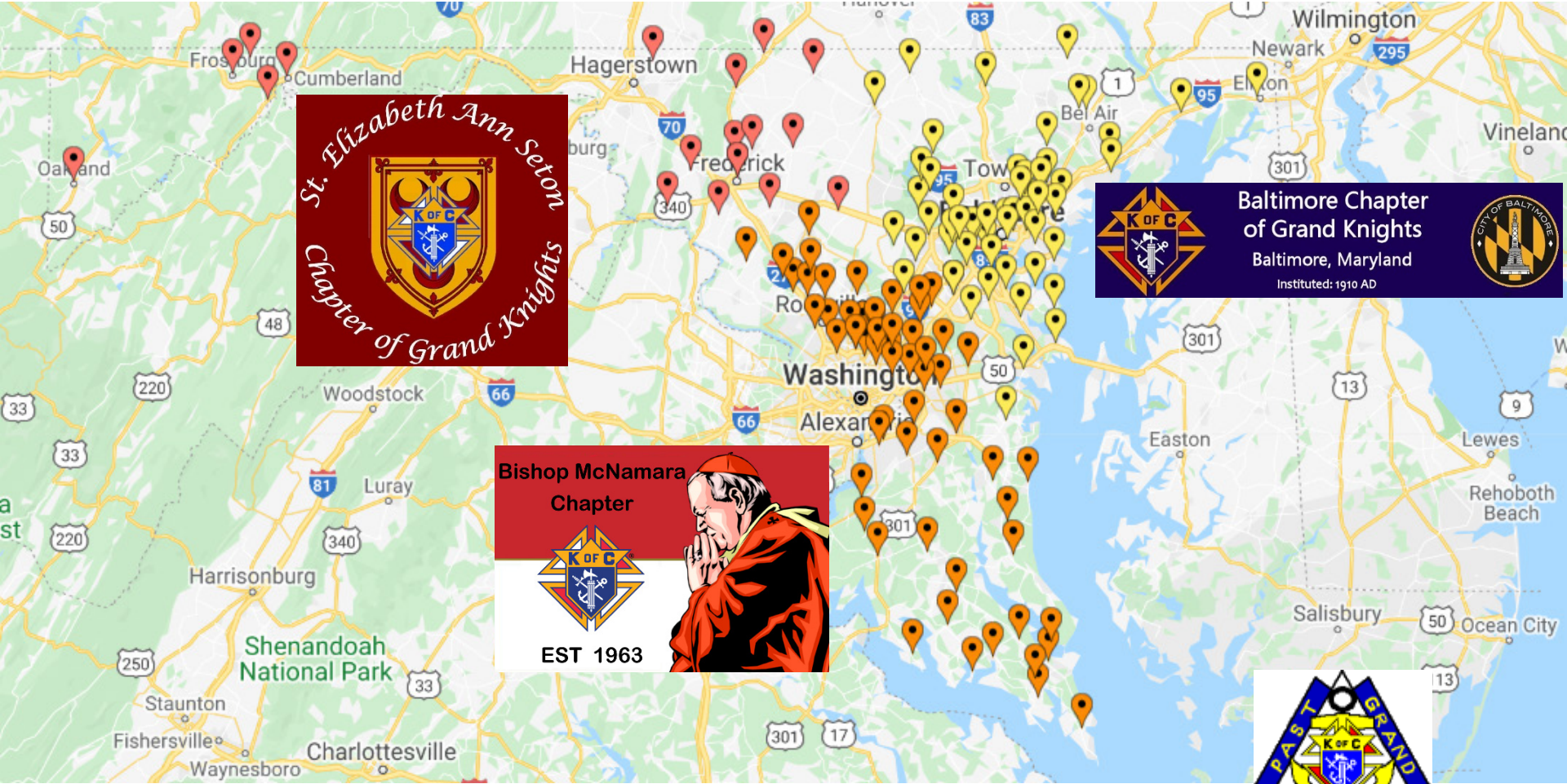


What Is A Chapter?

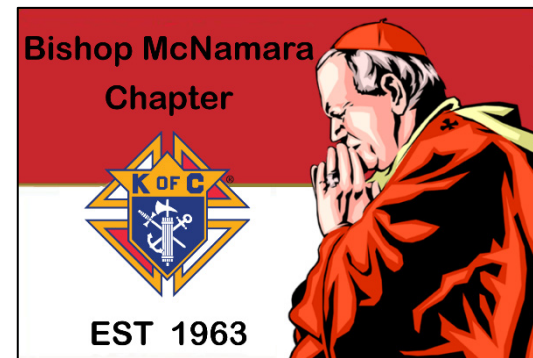

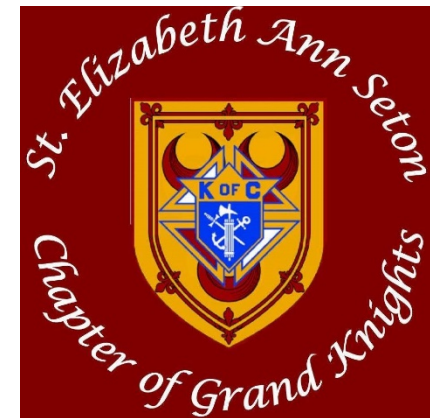
