



News for Knights of Columbus

The Knights of Columbus seeks to aid the most vulnerable wherever there is a need. K of C leaders in Canada recently stood up for the sanctity of life by participating in the National March for Life in Ottawa, while members in Puerto Rico helped rebuild their parish after it was devastated by a hurricane, and Knights in Ukraine continue to coordinate humanitarian relief for those displaced by war.

Separated by War, United by Prayer

Petro and Oksana Galuga left their home in Kyiv when Russia's attacks began on Feb. 24, and traveled to Lviv, more than 500 km (300 miles) to the west. Oksana, who has struggled with health issues, continued to Warsaw, Poland, where the older of their two sons has been studying for several years. Petro, the state secretary of the Knights of Columbus in Ukraine, remained to help coordinate the Order's humanitarian work while serving with State Deputy Yuriy Maletskiy on the Anti-Crisis Committee formed by the Archdiocese of Lviv. Star District Requirements

Founders Award (Insurance Growth)

Host two Fraternal Benefit Seminars (virtual or in-person)

Minimum of seven member or member eligible attendees per event



Star District Requirements

Founders Award

- Each council must participate in 2 Fraternal Benefits Nights
- Advertising is no longer sufficient (Minimum of 7 eligible participants)
- Submit the new form within 7 days



Fraternal Benefit Seminar Council Report Form

Councils striving for the Founder's Award must host (or co-host) two fraternal benefit seminars (in-person or virtual) per year. Each council must have a minimum of 7 members or member-eligible attendees at each seminar. Suggested methods of promotion include council email/social media, parish email/social media, pulpit announcement, bulletin notice, and personal outreach to prospects.
