

Star District Requirements



■ **Founders Award**

- Every Council in District
- Host or co-host Insurance Benefits night, minimum of 7 members or eligible attendees
- Submit Form #11077 to General Agent within 7 days



Star District Requirements



- **Growth**
 - 70% of Combined Council Growth Goals

- **Star Council**
 - Minimum of One Star Council in District

- **Form #944**
 - Must submit for every Council in District **even if Suspended**
