
Selling council retains .60 of each dollar to fund their charitable outreach and operating expenses

INTELLECTUALLY DISABLED PROGRAM

Monies collected supports the organizations your council chooses



- Timeline:
- May: Councils order tootsie rolls through the program chairmen
 - August: Tootsie rolls distributed to the councils
 - Sept/Oct: Councils conduct donation activities
 - November: Monies collected forwarded to the State
 - Dec/Jan: Presentations to recipient organizations by the council
 - Jan/Feb: Organizations receive checks from the State council





Box of Joy Program

"For Children Who Wish for Just One Gift"

Mission: Many children around the world come from families who cannot afford a single Christmas present. Your council can change that by providing shoebox-sized Christmas gifts for some of the world's poorest children

Action Steps: Sign-up to participate online. All materials are shipped at no charge, along with suggested gift items
Shipping cost are \$9 per box
Collection dates, locations and sign-up information will be provided





Coats for Kids

A Higher Purpose

Councils can purchase new winter coats for children in need at a discount and distribute them in their local communities

Action Steps: Contact the state council about assisting in a Coats for Kids event, or coordinate one in your community

Purchase coats through Knights Gear or another vendor

Coordinate the event within your community

Promote the event using posters, bulletin announcements, local media

Their Mission

To offer the neediest elderly a home where they will be welcomed as Christ, cared for as a family and accompanied with dignity until God call them to himself

Councils throughout the state provide support to homes in MD, DE and Wash DC, with donations of personal care items, food, office items, household items, and financial contributions.

Councils designated as “Hubs” collect donations from nearby councils and arrange deliveries to the homes on a monthly schedule.
