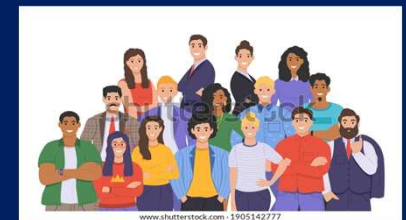

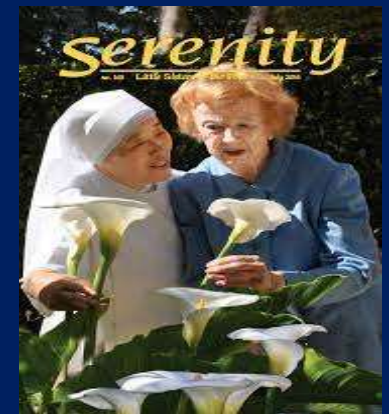


Mission: To offer the neediest elderly a home where they will be welcomed as Christ, cared for as a family, until God calls them to Himself
