There will be separate awards for each category selected from nominations submitted from all councils within the State of Maryland. The seven (7) State Awards will be presented at the Founder's Day Reception on Sunday, March 26, 2023

The Catholic Teacher of the Year program will allow your Council the opportunity to honor an individual that has made significant contributions to the education of our youth. This award is presented to a Catholic teacher who has demonstrated exceptional ability and dedication to the education of our young people through teaching in a parochial school.

The Faith Formation Catechist of the Year program will allow your Council to honor an individual that has dedicated themselves and made significant contributions to the religious education of our youth through your local parish's CCD program.

The Citizen of the Year program will allow your Council to honor someone who has made significant religious or civic contributions to the well-being of your community. To be eligible for this award, the nominee must be a resident of the State of Maryland.

The Law Enforcement Officer, Firefighter and EMT of the Year programs will allow your Council to honor Maryland public safety officers for their continuing commitments to enhancing and preserving the quality of life and protection of property within our communities.

The Healthcare Worker of the Year program will allow your Council to honor Maryland medical workers committed to preserving our health and wellness through their tireless and dedicated service.
