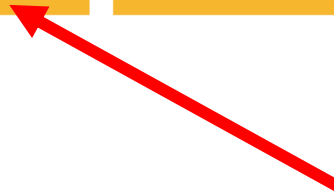
DISTRICT MEETINGS


