New members that are recruited as e-members or council members we are having less success reaching when they join. The new members we are seeing in many cases do not understand Father McGivney's mission or the Order's great works. I am asking that you encourage your members to meet with the fraternal benefits advisors representing your councils. We do not cover just the financial program. Rather we give an extensive presentation on the Order's history and the many charitable activities completed by both the Order and the individual councils. When we get a chance to meet with a new member, we encourage that they become active in their council.



- Both Maryland Insurance agencies have had a high rate of retirements of agents. We have a much higher agent retention rate than the industry, but retirements have created several opportunities in the state of Maryland.
- This has opened several territories in both agencies. We find that the best source for recruiting comes from the membership of the Order.



- The agent position offers many advantages including the ability to earn a good income, flexible full-time hours, and the ability to service brother Knights and their families.
- ▶ Both Stephan Regan and I are asking for the support of the leadership in the recruiting of KofC agents. To properly service the membership, we need to be fully staffed.
